MEET JOANN AND KELLY

Design partners Joann Kandrac and Kelly Kole can't help but be drawn to vivid hues. "They match our energy and outlook on life," Kelly says.

WHY YELLOW? "These heavier, richer yellows are not the pastel shades of the '80s. They look great with gray, from light smoky gray to charcoal, which is definitely the new neutral," Joann says.

CHIP TIP When picking multiple colors, use the gradations in paint fan decks to get hues of the same intensity. "Keep the palette within the same row," Kelly says. "If a medium-blue is three shades down on a paint chip, pick a yellow that's also three shades down."

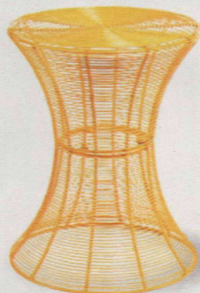
